This was followed by an introduction of the Education Department of MZU by Prof. Lalhmasai Chuaungo Dean, Faculty of Education, Mizoram University.

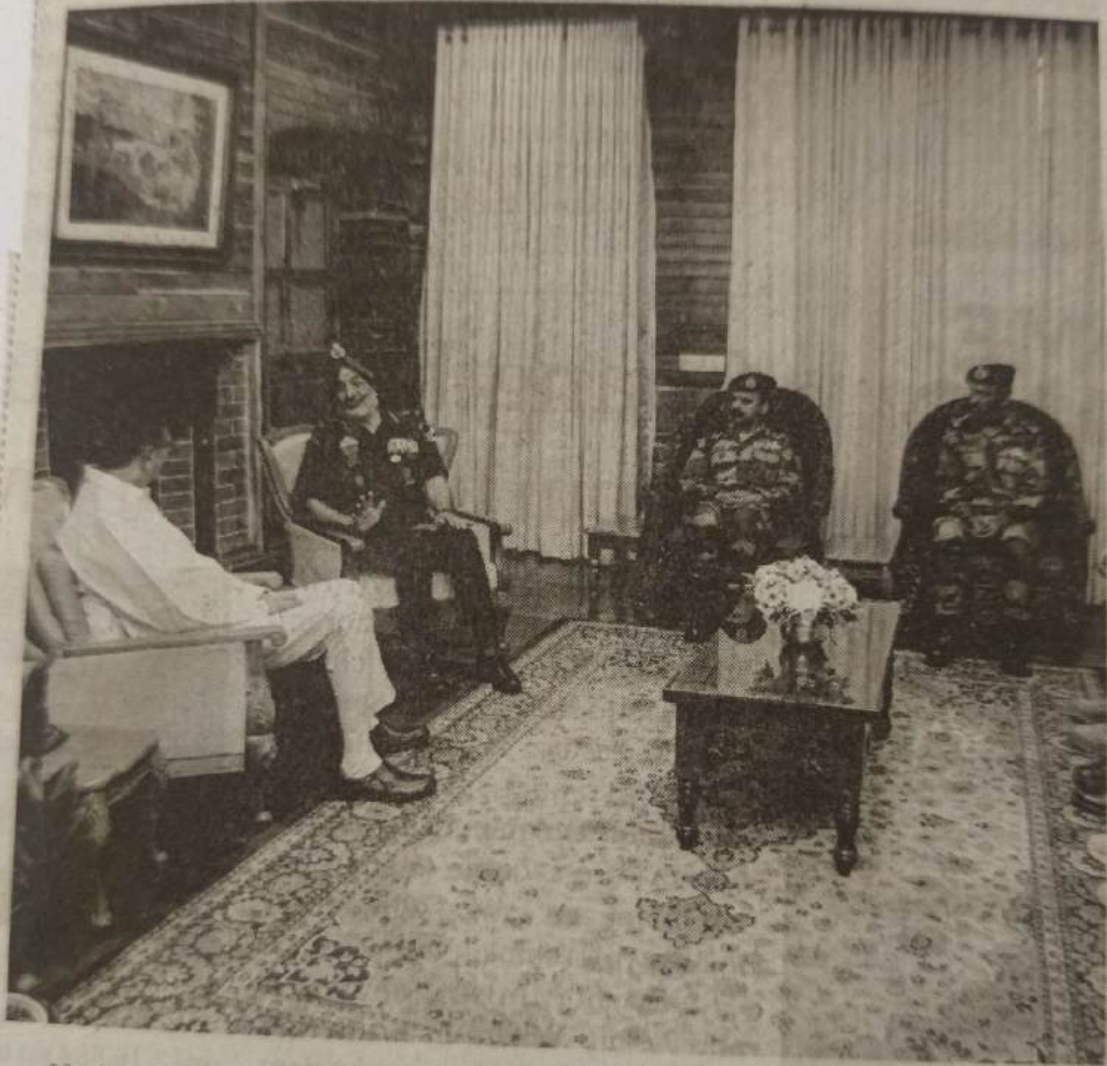

Nation-wide campaign on Ashwagandha & state level one-day workshop inaugurated

Aizawl, Mar 24: A nation-wide campaign on Ashwagandha & state level one-day workshop was inaugurated today at seminar hall, Education department, Mizoram University. Dr C Lalzepui, Principal Director, Health and Family Welfare Department, who is also member secretary, SMPB, Mizoram graced the occasion as chief guest.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr C Lalzepui mentioned that the State Medicinal Plant Board or SMPB was established in the year 2001 in Mizoram as a board under the direct administration of Health and Family Welfare Department.

However, in 2014, as the National Medicinal Plants Board was brought under the administration of the newly created Ministry of AYUSH by Government of India, in Mizoram, the State Medicinal Plants Board was also brought under the administration of the Directorate of AYUSH during financial year 2015-16.

The Principal Director also mentioned that as an agency, SMPB's mandate is to co-ordinate all matters relating to medicinal plants such as the cultivation, conservation, research and development and promotion of medicinal plants, towards which end SMPB has undertaken various awareness campaigns, set up nurseries for medicinal plants, established herbal gardens in Mizoram. Dr. C. Lalzepui also stated that SMPB Mizoram has successfully executed nationwide campaign on Amla-Sunhlu (Emblica officinalis) during 2014-2015, and Gine-Hrul-vankai (Tinospora cordifolia) during 2018-2019.

While thanking the organisers of the event for their tremendous effort, Dr. C. Lalzepui expressed hope that the nationwide campaign would be successfully observed in Mizoram and would go a long way in invigorating the awareness and practice of medicinal plants and enhance its relevance in the

contemporary society and wish the campaign a great success.

Dr. B. Mara Thansiam, Deputy Director, Directorate of AYUSH, also highlighted the importance of drugless therapy especially in today's world filled with stress and anxiety. She mentioned that therapy through exercise has great physical and stress management potential and invited the gathering to try and relieve their mental as well as physical discomfort and afflictions through AYUSH.

Prof. B.P. Mishra, Dean, School of Earth Sciences & Natural Resource Management, MZU also said that all plants have medicinal values, some of which are yet to be discovered. He mentioned that the knowledge of medicinal plants inherited from ancestors has been declining rapidly. Highlighting the health benefits of Ashwagandha, Prof. B.P. Mishra expressed his hope that due credit would be given to medicinal plants to encourage researchers and students to take more interest in medicinal plants.

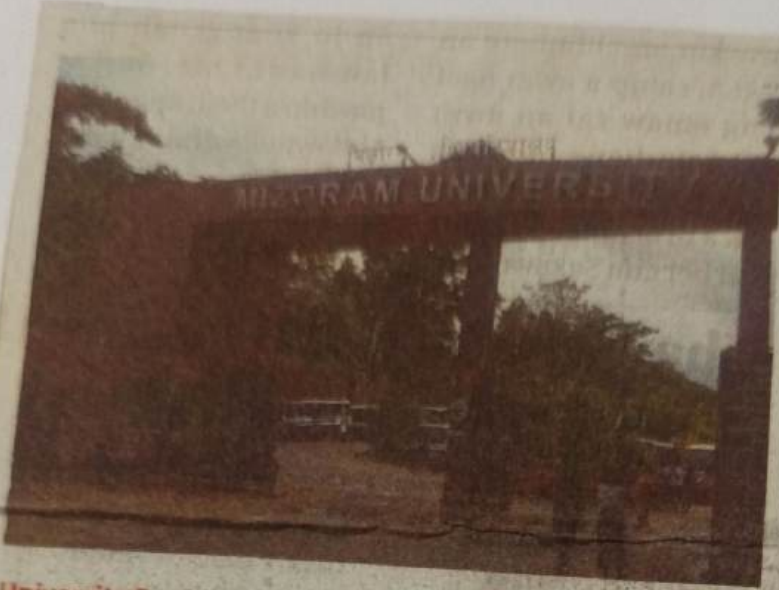

Mizoram University ranked 76th, PUC 34th

Aizawl, June 5: Mizoram University ranked 76th in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2023's University Category declared on 5th June, 2023. Mizoram University improved its ranking by two spots from 78th in the previous year. Tezpur University, Tezpur at rank 69 secured the highest ranking among the North Eastern universities followed by Mizoram University, Aizawl at 76 and North Eastern Hill University, Shillong at 80.

The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) was approved by the MHRD and launched by Honourable Minister of Human Resource Development on 29th September, 2015.

This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommen-

dations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception".

Mizoram University's constituent college, Pachhunga University College also improved its ranking from 45th Rank to 34th Rank in the College Category this year. Pachhunga University College in Aizawl, the oldest and largest college in Mizoram is ranked 34th in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) Ranking - 2023 (College Category) released on Monday.

Union Minister of State for Education and External Affairs Dr. Rajkumar Ranjan Singh made the announce-

ment.

The ranking was published by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. This is the 8th edition of the NIRF which is an annual exercise introduced in 2015 and there are 13 categories and domains of ranking in this year.

Altogether, 5,543 unit institutions participated for ranking in different categories. The college participated in the college level ranking.

This year, there are 2,746 participating colleges all over India, an increase of 474 colleges to last year's participation which was 2,272.

Overall 162 colleges from NE India participated and Pachhunga University College ranked 34th is the only college placed in the top 200 college ranking from North-East India.

Established in 1958, the college is the only constituent college of the Mizoram University in the state.

New species of gecko discovered in Vairengte, named after the town

Aizawl, Nov 13: In a groundbreaking discovery, scientists have identified a new species of *Cyrtodactylus*, a genus of geckos, in Vairengte town, located in the Kolasib district in Mizoram.

This finding marks the sixth endemic *Cyrtodactylus* species from Mizoram and the twenty-second from the broader north-eastern India region.

The research, led by a team of scientists from Mizoram University, utilised a combination of molecular analysis and morphological parameters to characterise the newly discovered species, named *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis*.

The scientists determined that *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis* is a member of the Indo-Burman *Cyrtodactylus khasiensis* clade, based on ND2 gene sequences and various

morphological features such as the number of precloacal pores, mid-ventral scale rows, paravertebral tubercles on the trunk, dorsal tubercle rows, subdigital lamellae on pes, and subcaudal scalation.

The phylogenetic evidence further indicates that the newly discovered species is closely related to *C. aaronbaueri*, a species recently described. Morphological analyses revealed slight distinctions between *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis* and *C. aaronbaueri*, particularly in the PCA (Principal Component Analysis) of infraorbitals, lamellae on fingers and toes, paravertebral tubercles on the trunk, and dorsal tubercle rows.

Cyrtodactylus, known as the third most speciose vertebrate genus globally, is widespread, ranging from South Asia to Melanesia. The genus comprises 335 species

grouped into 31 clades or groups. In India alone, there are currently 42 recognized species of *Cyrtodactylus*, with Mizoram contributing significantly to this diversity.

Previously, only *C. khasiensis* was known to inhabit Mizoram until recent studies challenged its occurrence in the state. The discovery of *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis*, along with five other species in Mizoram, underscores the richness of biodiversity in the region.

The researchers followed the classification proposed by Grismer et al. (2021), identifying four species groups within the 'khasiensis group.' This partitioning provides a more refined understanding of the

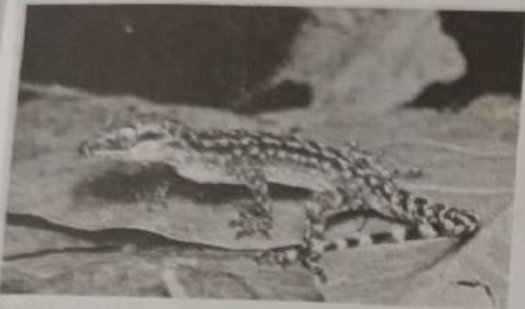

Previously, only *C. khasiensis* was known to inhabit Mizoram until recent studies challenged its occurrence in the state. The discovery of *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis*, along with five other species in Mizoram, underscores the richness of biodiversity in the region.

The researchers followed the classification proposed by Grismer et al. (2021), identifying four species groups within the 'khasiensis group.' This partitioning provides a more refined understanding of the

diversity within the genus.

To conduct their study, the scientists conducted extensive field surveys in the Kolasib District of Mizoram, obtaining necessary permissions for specimen collection. The collected samples were then preserved and deposited in the National Zoological Collection at Mizoram University.

Morphological analyses were performed, comparing the newly discovered species with known species from the 'khasiensis group' and *C. kamengensis* from the peguensis group. Additionally, molecular data, specifically ND2 gene sequences, were analyzed to provide further support for the species classification.

"The discovery of

Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis not only contributes to the scientific understanding of gecko diversity but also emphasizes the importance of continued research and conservation efforts in north-eastern India," team leader H T Lairemsanga said.

As habitats face various threats, including habitat loss and climate change, documenting and protecting unique species like *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis* becomes crucial for preserving biodiversity.

This groundbreaking research showcases the significance of collaborative efforts in uncovering and preserving the rich biodiversity of Mizoram and the broader north-eastern India region, Lairemsanga added.

New gecko species discovered in Mizoram

Aizawl: In a groundbreaking discovery, scientists have identified a new species of *Cyrtodactylus*, a genus of geckos, in Vairengte town of Mizoram's Kolasib district.

This finding marks the sixth endemic *Cyrtodactylus* species from Mizoram and the twenty-second from the broader northeast India region.

The research, led by a team of scientists from Mizoram University, utilised a combination of molecular analysis and morphological parameters to characterise the newly discovered species, named *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis*.



A new species of *Cyrtodactylus*

The scientists determined that *Cyrtodactylus vairengtensis* is a member of the Indo-Burman *Cyrtodactylus khasiensis* clade, based on ND2 gene sequences and various morphological features such as the number of preloacal pores, mid-ventral scale rows, paravertebral tubercles on the trunk, dorsal tubercle rows, subdigital lamellae on pes and subcaudal scalation.


